The Audio Ministry Leader is responsible for conceptualizing and creating an audio ministry that: enhances worship, supports other ministries and projects, builds a team of trained audio disciples, and serves the needs of the overall ministry mission and vision of Faith Lutheran Church.

This position directly report to and supports the Minister of Worship Arts and also coordinates with other Worship Ministry leaders and FLC staff. It is the responsibility of the Audio Ministry Leader to ensure that all venues have the highest quality audio possible and that Faith Lutheran Church maximizes current technologies in order to produce effective worship in regard to audio capability.

- Stay current with changing audio technologies; work with Minister of Worship Arts to ensure that FLC audio equipment is the best possible
- Manage/perform installation of audio equipment for any FLC venue or campus
